

My fellow Americans — [OC]

The time is 0900 on this 12th day of June in the year of our lord 2025. I wanted to take a moment to have a fireside chat with you all. To begin, I would like to ask some preliminary questions prior to the meat and potatoes. How do you feel about the current state of our country? Are we making the **UNITED** States great again? How do you feel about our involvement globally, as in, militarily, humanitarian aid, or how we are projecting ourselves as a country?

The next question is – do you know your neighbor? This is not a Mr. Rodgers episode, but I am asking this earnestly. Hussam had a wife and a daughter as well. How many of you have a wife, or a spouse, a domestic partner, a girlfriend, boyfriend, sibling, someone you care about. Could you imagine — what it would be like, when you get the news, that they are just gone. And not the type of gone like they died peacefully in the hospital bed. This man was taken from the world because of this conflict. Not only him, but his wife and daughter died in this attack.

Talking with people I have heard all kinds of scapegoats and arguments such as “He was probably a HAMAS sympathizer.” Or “He should not have been in the hospital then, because HAMAS is using the hospitals as cover.” This could all be true, but I was not there, and neither where any of the people who told me this. Just more claims digested and spat back out from

whatever media they consume. If we are talking facts, bottom line, a man, and his family are dead, and to top it off, his 2 sons are now war orphans, and as someone who grew up losing his dad at an early age this resonated with me, except these 2 boys are left in a war torn land without their parents, who will have to fend for themselves, and may or may not even survive this conflict due to the starvation and lack of resources for these Palestinians. When you think of it that way, it is much heavier; The idea carries more weight.

Could you imagine?

The website statista has some statistics posted (I have not personally fact checked this but I want to use it as a relevant example <https://www.statista.com/statistics/1422308/palestinian-territories-israel-number-fatalities-and-injuries-caused-by-the-israel-and-hamas-war/>), This bar graph reports that 50,149 people have died across the board in this conflict beginning from October 7th of 2023. In case you missed the number, fifty thousand one hundred and forty-nine people. Can you even imagine how many corpses that is? How many people do you know, as in, you really know them? Imagine, even the 1000, 500, 200, 100, 20, 10, 5, 1 — person(s) you know, and they are gone from this world, never to be spoken to again, never to share a beer, never to go dancing with, travel, raise hell at the rave, go to the range, talk to, cry with, love with, have dinner WITH, go to church WITH. All those opportunities are gone, that person's life is extinguished, and he nor his family will ever get to have any more of those experiences. To me, that is abhorrent. We should be ashamed this conflict has gone on for as long as it has, in this 21st century of man. Have we learned nothing of Iraq, have we learned nothing from Afghanistan, or Korea, Vietnam, World War II, or the Great War... It is a disrespect to all those millions if not billions of people who have died in that violence for the sake of liberty. Most of these mentioned wars are not even 100 hundred years old... Yet still, we as a species want to back pedal into the maw of the machine.

Freud and Jung:

Just like Vine, the not so successful Quip, and any other application figured out how to maximize engagement with its users. The likes, the messaging, notifications, trends, FOMO, badges, SALE! "LIKE AND FOLLOW!" LIMITED EDITION! Sorry, I digress. Anyways, have you ever thought about the fact that there are not that many apps that can compete with Elon, Mark, and Bezos. Elon bought fucking twitter, a social giant and converted it to X. Meta owns Facebook, Whatsapp (major communications application), and INSTAGRAM. So now we have established that Meta is using censorship across Instagram and Facebook, whose to say that Elon is not also doing it on X? Florida’s porn restrictions for the “sake of children” (The trojan horse)

They would then pretend to treat the patients, but what they were really doing was monitoring how the microbe presented itself in more advanced stages for medical research.
