1 Freedom is Dead And We Killed It

violated, and no warrants shall issue but upon probable cause, supported by oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched and the persons or things to be seized.", Amendment 5 "No person shall be held to answer for a capital or otherwise infamous crime unless on a presentment or indictment of a grand jury, except in cases arising in the land or naval forces, or in the militia, when in actual service in time of war or public danger; nor shall any person be subject for the same offense to be twice put in jeopardy of life or limb; nor shall be compelled in any criminal case to be a witness against himself, nor be deprived of life, liberty, or property without due process of law; nor shall private property be taken for public use without just compensation.", Amendment 6 "In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a speedy and public trial by an impartial jury of the state and district wherein the crime shall have been committed, which district shall have been previously ascertained by law, and to be informed of the nature and cause of the accusation; to be confronted with the witnesses against him; to have compulsory process for obtaining witnesses in his favor; and to have the assistance of counsel for his defense.", Amendment 7 "In suits at common law, where the value in controversy shall exceed twenty dollars, the right of trial by jury shall be preserved, and no fact tried by a jury shall be otherwise reexamined in any court of the United States than according to the rules of the common law", Amendment 8 "Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.", Amendment 9 "The enumeration in the Constitution of certain rights shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people.", Amendment 10 "The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the states, are reserved to the states respectively, or to the people."

Do you think all of Amendments are respected, surely the first ten are at least. First amendment the freedom of speech and religion, we can say what we want but then why do we have the FCC? Heymann of Harvard Law School.⁴ How can we call ourselves free? What you can and can not do is decided by other people you have little say in what you can and can not do. a lesser degree. This is what makes Free Software better and more ethical. I'm writing this in Emacs a Free Software tool, this is on top of GNU/Linux.

GNU was started by Richard Stallman and is now the biggest free operating system (that and BSD), he also made the GPL (GNU General Public License) which I do not completely agree with but is OK. He did this for reason explained in The GNU Manifesto. Using Free Software is the most ethical way to spread anti-tech ideas.

3 The Earth is Crying
