These irradiated diabetic primates demonstrate insulin resistance and hypertriglyceridemia, however, they lack the typical obese presentation of primate midlife diabetogenesis. Surprisingly, body composition analyses by computed tomography indicated that prior irradiation led to a specific loss of visceral fat mass. Prior irradiation led to

reductions in insulin signaling effectiveness in skeletal muscle and higher monocyte chemoattractant protein 1 levels, indicative of increased inflammation.

Because visceral adiposity is strongly linked to insulin resistance, we speculate that this preferential increase in visceral adiposity might contribute to relative β -cell insufficiency with insulin resistance developing in adulthood. This hypothesis warrants further prospective study.

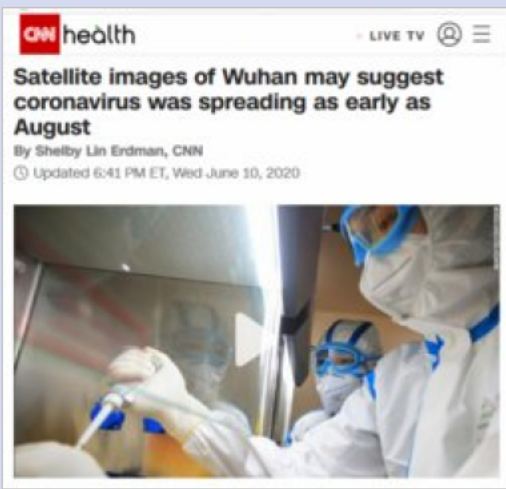

Working with nuclear secrets stolen from an American Government laboratory, China has made a leap in the development of nuclear weapons: the miniaturization of its bombs, according to Administration officials.

Until recently, China's nuclear weapons designs were a generation behind those of the United States, largely because Beijing was unable to produce small warheads that could be launched from a single missile at multiple targets and form the backbone of a modern nuclear force.

But by the mid-1990's, China had built and tested such small bombs, a breakthrough that officials say was accelerated by the theft of American nuclear secrets from Los Alamos National Laboratory in New Mexico.

The espionage is believed to have occurred in the mid-1980's, officials said. But it was not detected until 1995, when Americans analyzing Chinese nuclear test results found similarities to America's most advanced miniature warhead, the W-88.

By the next year, Government investigators had identified a suspect, an American scientist at Los Alamos laboratory, where the atomic bomb was developed. The investigators also concluded that Beijing was continuing to steal secrets from the Government's major nuclear weapons laboratories, which had been increasingly opened to foreign visitors since the end of the cold war.

Nearly every day brings fresh evidence of the malfeasance, corruption and recklessness that led to the Deepwater Horizon disaster, provoking widespread rage at BP and by implication the rest of the oil industry. Public anger at the Obama administration festers, too, as citizens recognize the pitiful impotence of the federal government in these circumstances. But are they furious enough to consider a radical response? If voters are sick of corporate misconduct and government paralysis, after all, there is an alternative to both: nationalization – or at least public development of petroleum resources on federal property.

By the end of the March 2016 FCC wireless spectrum auction, as the repurposed broadband spectrum was sold off for 5G cellular service, everyone knew that 5G would begin being rolled out in the next few year.

The exact dates would vary by cellular provider and each would own licenses for different parts of the spectrum.

But by March 2016 everyone knew it was coming soon. So, if Dr. Cowan's hypothesis is correct and, separately, if anyone knew that radiation/electrification step-ups caused radiation poisoning pandemics but were described as 'influenza pandemics', then those

Each bidder in the forward auction was required to bid on 95 percent of census blocks in which an interest was shown. As of August, Comcast, AT&T, T-Mobile, Verizon and others had submitted bids for 100 MHz of spectrum in the forward auction totaling over \$11 billion, with the goal \$88.4 billion.

Only \$22.45 billion had been raised when the FCC ended stage one of the forward auction after two weeks.[59] After the second stage of the reverse auction, the target for stage two of the forward auction was 114 MHz, with the desired goal \$54.6 billion, enough for two channels per market. With less spectrum to be purchased, lower demand could mean lower costs for wireless providers. Failure of stage two could reduce the target further, to 108 MHz, or one channel per market. If stage three also fails, the target could even be 84 MHz, an additional four channels per market. The lower the target, the lower the amount paid to stations, but the fewer the number of public stations that could participate. And public stations that are not "repacked" must pay for their own equipment upgrades.

Stage two of the forward auction ended October 19 with \$21.5 billion in total bids, \$33.1 billion less than expected. The reverse auction's third stage began November 1 with a 108 MHz target. The number of paired blocks per market started at 10, reduced to 9 in stage two, and 8 in stage three. Four impaired blocks, with interference in less than 15 percent of an area, protected Mexican channels below 37. Two markets had interference in 15 to 50 percent of an area.

Stage three of the forward auction began December 5 after total bids for stage three were \$40.3 billion for 108 MHz. Stage four of the reverse auction ended January 13, 2017 with \$10.05 billion paid for 84 MHz, or seven licenses in each market. 70 MHz of that goes to the wireless companies, with 14 MHz for unlicensed use. With less spectrum cleared, fewer stations will move and none will be in the buffer or wireless bands.

Bidding ended March 30, and on April 12, the FCC announced the completion of the incentive auction. The auction raised \$19.8 billion and made more spectrum available for faster 5G service. Nearly \$10.1 billion goes to 175 TV stations, \$7.3 billion to the United States Treasury, and \$1.8 billion to assist with the repacking process. Lawrence Chu, an advisor to the FCC during the bidding process, considered the auction a success while admitting that "there will be some people disappointed on the broadcaster side."

T-Mobile paid almost \$8 billion for 1,525 licenses representing 45 percent of low-band spectrum, giving the company coverage of the entire country and about four times the spectrum it had, while Dish Network spent \$6.2 billion on 486 licenses and Comcast received 73 licenses for its \$1.7 billion bid. AT&T bid \$910 million 23 licenses and U.S. Cellular bid \$328.6 million on 188 licenses.

The telecommunications industry and their experts have accused many scientists who have researched the effects of cell phone radiation of "fear mongering" over the advent of wireless technology's 5G. Since much of our research is publicly-funded, we believe it is our ethical responsibility to inform the public about what the peer-reviewed scientific literature tells us about the health risks from wireless radiation.

The chairman of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) recently announced through a press release that the commission will soon reaffirm the radio frequency radiation (RFR) exposure limits that the FCC adopted in the late 1990s. These limits are based upon a behavioral change in rats exposed to microwave radiation and were

designed to protect us from short-term heating risks due to RFR exposure.

Yet, since the FCC adopted these limits based largely on research from the 1980s, the preponderance of peer-reviewed research, more than 500 studies, have found harmful biologic or health effects from exposure to RFR at intensities too low to cause significant heating.

Citing this large body of research, more than 240 scientists who have published peer-reviewed research on the biologic and health effects of nonionizing electromagnetic fields (EMF) signed the International EMF Scientist Appeal, which calls for stronger exposure limits. The appeal makes the following assertions:

“Numerous recent scientific publications have shown that EMF affects living organisms at levels well below most international and national guidelines. Effects include increased cancer risk, cellular stress, increase in harmful free radicals, genetic damages, structural and functional changes of the reproductive system, learning and memory deficits, neurological disorders, and negative impacts on general well-being in humans. Damage goes well beyond the human race, as there is growing evidence of harmful effects to both plant and animal life.”

The scientists who signed this appeal arguably constitute the majority of experts on the effects of nonionizing radiation. They have published more than 2,000 papers and letters on EMF in professional journals.

He most likely misspelled the word "coverage," but swore that "covfefe" was intentional. Trump even had his then press secretary, Sean Spicer, tell everyone that the combination of letters made sense to "a small group of people."

The term "covfefe" was heavily meme'd, inspired some merch, and even led Democratic Representative Mike Quigley to introduce a "Covfefe Act," which expanded the Presidential Records Act to include any social media posts shared by the president, not just posts shared from the official @POTUS accounts.

Trump's possible typo also inspired the name of an award-winning race horse, who recently won a Breeder's Cup event at Santa Anita Park in California. And when the Daily Caller tweeted news of the horse's win and explained that she's named after Trump's "famous mistweet," the president chimed in to argue, once again, that he meant to tweet "covfefe" all along.
