

Rick Callender Valley Water

Joone Lopez is the General Manager of the Moulton Niguel Water District, which provides water, wastewater and recycled water services to six cities in South Orange County. Before joining Moulton Niguel, she served as the General Manager of Calaveras County Water District located in Northern California. Joone's prior experience includes working for Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company as its Assistant General Manager and serving as the Deputy General Manager of Central Basin Municipal Water District.



Jose Martinez **Otay Water District**

Jose Martinez is the General Manager of the Otay Water District. He has served in the utility industry for more than 18 years in private and public sectors, managing multimillion-dollar engineering and construction projects. Jose is a U.S. Navy veteran where he served as a Nuclear Submarine Officer, Jose has a Bachelor of Science in mechanical engineering from the U.S. Naval Academy.



California's Natural **Resources Secretary**

Prior to leading the Natural Resources Agency, Secretary Crowfoot served as chief executive officer of the Water Foundation, a nonprofit philanthropy that builds shared water solutions across the American West. Before that Crowfoot served in Governor Jerry Brown's Administration as deputy cab-Wade Crowfoot inet secretary and senior advisor to the Governor. He also previously served as West Coast regional director for the Environmental Defense Fund and a senior environmental advisor to then-San Francisco Mayor Gavin Newsom.



Jasmin Hall **Inland Empire** Water Authority

IEUA President Jasmin Hall also serves as President of the California Association of Sanitation Agencies (CASA); Chair of the Santa Ana Watershed Project Authority Commission; President of the Chino Basin Regional Financing Authority: Director of the Inland Empire Regional Composting Authority. Director Hall also serves as a representative to the Association of California Water Agencies. President Hall initiated the process that earned Inland Empire Utilities Agency the Special District Leadership Foundation's District Transparency Certificate of Excellence.
