

The firm of Eickhorn, Solingen, and NWM De Kruithoorn N.V., 's-Hertogenbosch, as a joint venture, have designed and developed a new type of combat knife, which can be used as a wire cutter, as a bayonet and as an emergency saw.

The KCB 70 has been constructed to allow the cutting of high tension wires with a voltage of up to 20,000 Volts, by isolating the scabbard and the knife-handle from the metal parts.

An extension at the end of the scabbard is formed to be used as a large screw-driver.

The handle is partly hollow and can be used as a container. The sight adjustment tool for the Stoner 63A1 Weapons is fitted inside, but any other part - if the dimensions are right - can be put in according to the customer's wishes.

The following pictures show the use of the KCB 70 which, as a bayonet, can be fixed on the Stoner 63A1 Weapons, e.g.:

Rifle	XM 22
Carbine	XM 23
MG	XM207
and the M16	

If required, the fixtures for mounting the bayonet can be adapted to any other weapon.


Details of KCB 70

Total length	303 mm (11.9 inch)
Length of the blade	175 mm (6.9 inch)
Width of the blade	30 mm (1.2 inch)
Weight with scabbard	0,480 kg (0.90 lbs)
Weight knife only	0,250 kg (0.55 lbs)
Electrical isolation	up to 20,000 Volts.


