

HOLD THEM ACCOUNTABLE for Cuts to Medicaid and SNAP



- Congressional Republicans passed a budget resolution early this morning that would cut more than \$1 trillion in funding toward health care, education, and other vital services, all to fund their tax cuts to the rich and corporations.
- Medicaid would be cut by \$700+ billion, potentially leading to 9+ million people losing coverage.
- \$300 billion in key nutritional programs would be cut. These cuts could eliminate or reduce SNAP benefits for more than 40 million Americans.

Republican-Approved Cuts to Medicaid & SNAP



House Republican Plan Would Take Health Care and Food Assistance Away from People to Pay for Tax Cuts for Wealthy

Plan would cut health coverage by at least \$800 billion and SNAP by roughly \$300 billion while giving the wealthy \$1.1 trillion in tax cuts

Cuts to SNAP \$300 billion

Cuts to Medicaid and ACA \$800+ billion

Tax cuts for people with incomes above \$500K \$1.1 trillion

How to Use the MoveOn Dialer

- ★ The MoveOn Dialer is a predictive-dialer calling system.
- ★ It automatically dials from a list of numbers.
- ★ It connects you only to people who answer the phone.
- ★ This means that you can call 10x as many people!






MoveOn Dialer: Dial With Phone for Audio


- ★ Once you enter your phone number, you will get a telephone number to call to connect your phone with the dialer on your screen.


Tips for Making Calls

Disconnect audio before going to make calls!




In the bottom-left corner of your Zoom screen, click ^ to the right of the microphone icon.

Choose "Leave computer audio."

If you are using a tablet or a mobile device, you may need to leave Zoom for the dialer to work.

 In the bottom-left corner of your Zoom screen, click "Join audio."

 If prompted, choose "Join With Computer Audio."

STEP 1: Disconnect Zoom Audio

- Click on the tiny caret (^) button next to your microphone button.
- · Select "Leave computer audio."
- On phones/tablets, this is sometimes located inside the "More" control, a circle with three dots inside, on the far right (you may need to scroll).



STEP 2:

Connect to the Dialer

- Open your internet browser (Chrome, Firefox, Safari, etc.).
- · Type in MoveOn.org/Call
- Once you're ready, choose either "call with this device" or "call with this device + phone for audio."



STEP 3:

Allow the Website Access to your Microphone

- After submitting your name and phone number, the next screen will show a popup window asking permission to use your microphone.
- Be sure to click "Allow." Otherwise, the voter will not be able to hear you.
