STATE OF OKLAHOMA, COUNTY OF LEFLORE:

I, Jeffrey C. Smith, the undersigned District Attorney of said County, in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, give information that in LeFlore County, Oklahoma, BOB LEE ALLEN, acting in concert with THOMAS EVANS GATES did then and there unlawfully, willfully, knowingly and wrongfully commit the crime(s) of:

count 1: conspiracy to commit unlicensed surgery ~ a FeLony, on or between the 1st day of September, 2020 and the 12th day of October, 2020, by conspiring and agreeing with each other and to commit the crime of unlicensed gender reassignment surgery, a felony, and said defendants did in fact perform said unlicensed surgery upon the body of in furtherance of the conspiracy.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment for up to 10 years, or a fine of up to \$5,000, or both.

PRACTICING MEDICINE WITHOUT A LICENSE/UNLICENSED SURGERY ~ a FELONY, on or about the 12th day of October, 2020, by performing a surgery on to-wit: removal of the scrotum and testicles, without first being in legal possession of an unrevoked license or certificate issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act or the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act. This crime is punishable by a fine in an amount not less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not more than one (1) year or imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term of not more than four (4) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment. COUNT 3: MAIMING ~ a FELONY, on or about the 12th day of October, 2020, by inflicting physical injury with a premeditated design to injure, maim and commit mayhem on the body of performing an unlicensed medical procedure that resulted in the permanent removal of and testicles and dispensing lidocaine, hydrocodone and other medications throughout and after the procedure. This crime is punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000 or imprisonment for up to life, or both. UNLAWFUL USE OF COMMUNICATION FACILITY ~ a FELONY, on or about the 12th day of October, 2020, by willfully using a communication facility, to wit. electronic communication, to facilitate the commission of the crime of distribution of narcotic drugs or other controlled dangerous substance(s). This crime is punishable by a fine of not less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by imprisonment of not more than five (5) years, or by both. DISTRIBUTION OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE -COUNT 5: POSSESSION WITH INTENT TO DISTRIBUTE ~ a FELONY, on or about the 12th day of October, 2020, by knowingly distributing hydrocodone, a controlled dangerous substance in Schedule II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act of Oklahoma to This crime is punishable by imprisonment for up to 7 years to Life and/or a fine of up to \$100,000. COUNT 6: ASSAULT AND BATTERY WITH A DANGEROUS WEAPON ~ a FELONY, on or about the 12th day of October, 2020, by willfully and unlawfully assaulting and battering the body of and altering his penis resulting in permanent scalpels to remove the scrotum and testicles of , in LeFlore County. disfigurement to the body of This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the Department of Corrections for up to 10 years or in the county jail for up to 1 year. COUNT 7: FAILURE TO BURY A DEAD HUMAN MEMBER ~ a MISDEMEANOR, on or about the 12th day of October, 2020, by dissecting a member of sound body, to-wit: scrotum and testicles, and failing to bury the dead limb or member of the human body, separated therefrom during s lifetime and instead stored them in a refrigerator/freezer. This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for up to 1 year and/or a fine of up to \$500.

COUNT 8: POSSESSION OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE ~ a MISDEMEANOR, on or about the 12th day of October, 2020, by knowingly and intentionally having in defendant's possession under defendant's control PSILOCYBIN MUSHROOMS, said drug being classified as a controlled dangerous substance in Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act of Oklahoma.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment for not more than one (1) year and by a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

COUNT 9: UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA ~ a MISDEMEANOR, on or about the 12th day of December, 2020, by possessing syringes which is used by abusers of drugs classified as Controlled Dangerous Substances and without having any medical or other lawful need requiring possession of said paraphernalia.

The crime is punishable by imprisonment for up to 1 year or a fine of up to \$1,000 or both.



On Wednesday, October 14, 2020 at approximately 16:28 hours, I Deputy Tyler Newby with the Leffore County Sheriff's Office received a call from dispatch stating that they received a call from McAlester Regional Hospital that they had a male subject there in room 247 whom they identified as DOB 07/01/1992.
Medical Personnel informed dispatch that told them that he had "Surgery" in Wister and gave address 45145 Blake Drive in Wister. It told medical personnel that the surgery was to remove his testicles. Medical personnel confirmed that the surgery was to remove his testicles. On this same date at approximately 20:20 hours, I Deputy Tyler Newby with the Leflore County Sheriff's Office and Investigator Jim Craig with the Leflore County District Attorney's Office arrived at McAlester Regional Hospital to speak with
explained that he first had contact with a Bob Allen approximately three weeks ago on a website called www.the-em.com. stated that he came across the website while searching about castrations and ochis. said that him and Allen chatted for a few days and then talked on "skype." said that Allen informed him that he had 15 years of experience and that he videous the procedures for personal use.
informed us that he lived in Virginia and that he set up a flight on September 28, 2020 after Alien told him that the surgery wouldn't cost him anything.
stated that he flew into the Dallas/Fort Worth airport on Sunday, October 11, 2020 and was picked up by a man that identified himself as Bob Allen. stated that Allen was driving a Metallic Gray, Toyota Highlander. stated that Allen drove him to his address located at 45145 Blake Drive in Wister. explained that when they arrived at Allen's residence it was late in the evening. said that Allen told him that he would do the surgery the next day (Monday). stated that once they got to Allen's residence he went to the bedroom and went so sleep and when he woke up Monday morning he asked Allen to do the surgery and Allen told him that he had to work until 5pm on the internet.
stated that on Monday, October 12, 2020 at approximately 1700 hours Allen had him to get on what he described to be a make shift table that was covered in gowns and operation gowns, believed that the table was wood. It is stated that prior to the surgery Allen prepped him by first wiping him down with something that he was unaware of it being. Then injected him with novocaine or Lidocaine in the needed areas. It is stated that he was awake during the surgery. It is explained that Allen performed the surgical removal and stated that Allen removed his scrotum and testicles by using surgical equipment. It is stated that Allen had numerous surgical equipment. It is stated that Allen had numerous surgical equipment. It is stated that the surgery took approximately two hours. It is stated that after the surgery was over that Allen said that he was going to consume the parts and laughed and said that he was a cannibal. It is said that he then told him about the time where he worked on someone that he described to be crazy and that he left the male opened up to die overnight. It is stated that Allen had six more clients on the way to have the same operation. It is said that Allen informed him that he had a freezer with body parts and showed him pictures on his phone and also stated that he had videos of procedures in his computers and flash drives and offered to show the but he refused to watch.
said shortly after the surgery he went to sleep and woke up on Tuesday morning with a lot of bleeding and also said that he passed out, said the then begin call for Allen and Allen told him "No ER, No Morgue". said that Allen finally decided to take him to the McAlester Regional Hospital and while en route Allen told him that if he passed out or died that he would durnp him in the woods.
also informed us that Allen had a medicine cabinet containing all types of medicine such as Hydro, OxyContin, Percocet, Shrooms and stated that Allen told him that he also had "hard drugs."
The directions to the residence to be searched is, Turn west off of Us Highway 271 onto Leftore Road and travel 5.9 miles west to South Booth Street, Once at South Booth Street you turn South and travel 1.6 miles to Blake Loop once on Blake loop travel SW

The directions to the residence to be searched is, Turn west off of Us Highway 271 onto Leffore Road and travel 5.9 miles west to South Booth Street. Once at South Booth Street you turn South and travel 1.6 miles to Blake Loop once on Blake loop travel SW for 0.9 miles to Blake Drive. Once on Blake drive you turn south and travel 0.1 mile and arrive to Allen's residence on the west side of the road.

The residence to be searched is a tan two bedroom oilfield bunk house with brown trim that sets approximately 75 yards off the road. The entrance to the property has two green double metal gates, and two painted multicolored pieces of wood. One is on a T-post and the other is lying on the ground. One is on one side of the driveway and the other is on the other side of the driveway. Also there are two orange safety cones at the entrance, one on each side of the driveway.

On Thursday, October 15, 2020 I Deputy Tyler Newby with the Leffore County Sheriff's Office generated an affidavit for a search warrant for an address located at 45145 Blake Drive in Wister, Ok. On this same date I took the search warrant to Judge Marion

Fry for him to review and issue the search warrant. At approximatly 4:42pm Judge Fry granted the search warrant with todays date and his signature.

On this same date, I Deputy Tyler Newby along with the Leflore County Shariffs Department went to the listed address in the search warrant to execute the search warrant. We arrived on scene at approximately 1800 hours. When arriving on scene I observed that their was no vehicles at the residence. I then immediately went to the front door to get into position to make entry into the home at the front door. The front door was facing east towards Blake Drive. Once in position at the front I knocked numerous times and announced "Sheriff's Office, Search Warrant," I gave time for a person(s) to get from the furthest point of the residence to get to the door. I checked the front door to ensure that It was not unlocked. I then breached the front door by kicking near the door jam. I then made entry into the residence and assisted Deputy Jake Tucker clearing the back bedroom located on the south end of the residence. The residence appeared to be unoccupied.

During the search of the listed items in the search warrant I was advised that Bob Allen and Thomas Gatas was back at the McAlaster Regional Hospital. McAlaster Police Department responded to the Hospital where they then Took Allen and Gates into Custody and held them until the search warrant was complete.

Throughout the search the following itams were located and later taken into evidence.

In the kitchen I located a silver Mac-Book taptop and also a black I enovo Laptop lying on a black table next to the wall towards the south side of the kitchen.

I then located the kitchen table on the north end of the kitchen where I observed Medical Bill addressed to Bob Allen. The letter was not taken into avidence, only photographed. I also located a bill bottle containing Epitol 200mg and showed prescribed to Thomas Gales. Also a black Aero Laptop and a outer hard drive. On the kitchen table I observed a Roto-Rooter invoice addressed to Allen with address 45145 Blake Dr. In the kitchen there also plywood that we believed that was used as the make shift table.

At the south end of the residence across the entry to the restroom was a gray in color approx 6ft medicine cabinet against the east side wall. The Medicine cabinet contained numerous medications, pill bottle containing mushrooms, numerous medical utensils. In the medicine cabinet also located a military back containing utensils. Cartery tool with blood. Xytocaine bottle in flower box.

South end bedroom I located a locker containing bags of mushrooms, also in the bedroom I located a red and black medical bag containing utensile. In the southend bedroom there was also a deep freeze that contained a plastic zip lock bag with what appeared to be testicles.

South and bathroom I observed that there was a small blue in color tub that that contained what appeared to be dired blood.

In the fiving room also found two ftash drives on a shelve. Also in the living room I found a box of restraint straps next to the medicine cabinet. Between the living room and north end restroom I located a white trash can containing a blue plastic medical sheet with a needle and small string, also what appeared to be a white doggy pad with blood. In there hallway I observed dvd disc on the shelves.


In the north end fridge I located syringes containing a clear Equid substance. North end bedroom bed I found adult diapers.

Once finished locating evidence and togging it we then took it into evidence. After completing the search warrant Deputy Gary Summers transported the evidence to the Leflore County Sheriffs Office.

Deputy Casey Linville and Reserve Deputy Landon Heatherington transported Allen and Gates from the Pittsburg County Sheriff's Office to the Leftors County Sheriff's Office to bunking.
