

HILLARY CLINTON
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ROBBY MOOK
Campaign manager for Clinton campaign
Mook was one of the first to promote the theory that Russia was helping Trump.

DONNA BRAZILE
Interim chairman of the Democratic National Committee (DNC)
Brazile helped promote the Russia-collusion narrative. She has received a letter of inquiry from Sen. Chuck Grassley.

DEBBIE WASSERMAN SCHULTZ
Chairwoman of the DNC
After CrowdStrike was hired to investigate the alleged Russian hack of the DNC's servers, Wasserman Schultz refused to provide the FBI access to the servers.

JAKE SULLIVAN
Senior policy adviser to Clinton campaign
Along with Jennifer Palmieri, Sullivan took the lead in briefing the press on the Trump-Russia-collusion story.

JOEL BENENSON
Partner at Perkins Coie
Benenson was a strategist for Barack Obama's 2008 and 2012 presidential campaigns. He has received a letter of inquiry from Sen. Chuck Grassley.

JENNIFER PALMIERI
Communications director for the Clinton campaign
Along with Jake Sullivan, Palmieri took the lead in briefing the press on the Trump-Russia-collusion story.

ALEXANDRA CHALUPA
Ukrainian-American operative and consultant for the DNC
Chalupa met with top officials in the Ukrainian Embassy in Washington in an effort to expose alleged ties between President Donald Trump, Paul Manafort, and Russia. The DNC paid her \$412,000 from 2014 to mid-2016, according to Federal Election Commission records.

PERKINS COIE
A law firm that represented the Clinton campaign and the Democratic National Committee.

BOB BAUER
Partner at Perkins Coie, former White House counsel to President Barack Obama
In 2013, Obama named Bauer to be co-chair of the Presidential Commission on Election Administration. Bauer was a partner at Perkins Coie for 25 years until his retirement in May 2018. Bauer was general counsel to Obama's campaign organization, Obama for America, in 2008 and 2012, and served as general counsel to the Democratic National Committee.

MICHAEL SUSSMANN
Partner at Perkins Coie
Sussmann passed on information to FBI General Counsel James Baker alleging that Russia's Alfa Bank was communicating with Trump Tower—a claim later proven false. He also passed the same information to The New York Times and possibly other media. Sussmann and Baker knew each other from their work at the DOJ. Sussmann was responsible for retaining CrowdStrike to examine the Democratic National Committee servers after the alleged hacking incident.

CROWDSTRIKE
Cybersecurity company
CrowdStrike was hired by Perkins Coie lawyer Michael Sussmann as well as members of the Democratic National Committee's servers. The FBI was refused access to independently examine the DNC servers.

JAMES COMEY
FBI director
Comey oversaw all FBI operations, including the examination of Hillary Clinton and the Trump-Russia investigation. He reported to Attorney General Loretta Lynch.
Comey briefed President-elect Donald Trump on the dossier on Jan. 6, 2017, at the instruction of James Clapper.
Comey later leaked copies of his memo, two of which were classified, to Daniel Richman. It is likely that a special counsel would not have been appointed without Comey leaking the memo.

ANDREW MCCABE
FBI deputy director
McCabe was involved in all aspects of the FBI's counterintelligence investigation into Trump. A text sent by FBI agent Peter Strzok describes a meeting in McCabe's office and makes reference to a so-called "insurance policy" against Trump.
McCabe was fired by Attorney General Jeff Sessions on March 16, 2018.
McCabe was referred by the DOJ inspector general to federal prosecutors in New York about having authorized selective leaks to media.

JAMES BAKER
FBI general counsel
Baker was the most senior legal counsel at the FBI. He worked closely with Andrew McCabe and Trisha Anderson. Baker received documentation from Perkins Coie lawyer Michael Sussmann alleging Russia's Alfa Bank was communicating with Trump Tower.
Baker received additional parts of the Steele dossier from Mother Jones reporter David Corn. Baker is the subject of a criminal leak investigation.

PETER STRZOK
FBI deputy assistant director of counterintelligence
Strzok was the lead agent on both the FBI's investigation of Hillary Clinton and the Trump-Russia investigation. Strzok was a member of the "insurance policy" group that worked closely with Andrew McCabe.
Thousands of text messages sent between Strzok and FBI lawyer Lisa Page reveal a strong bias in favor of Clinton and against Trump.

LISA PAGE
Special counsel to FBI Deputy Director Andrew McCabe
Page was a primary conduit for McCabe in the FBI's investigation of Clinton—the Trump campaign.
She was a member of the "insurance policy" group that worked closely with Andrew McCabe.
The DOJ inspector general uncovered thousands of text messages sent between her and Peter Strzok that reveal a strong bias against Trump and in favor of Clinton.
Page was part of the team of special counsel Robert Mueller before being demoted on Aug. 16, 2017. Page resigned on May 4, 2018.

JONATHAN MOFFA
FBI analyst
Moffa, along with Peter Strzok, was a leader of the FBI's investigative team in both the counterintelligence investigation of the Trump campaign as well as the Mid-Year Exam investigation of Hillary Clinton.
Moffa and Strzok oversaw the core investigation team by Rick Maass, Assistant Major and Strzok was Sally Moore, a counterintelligence lawyer. Moffa, who was a senior intelligence analyst and not an FBI agent, reported to Bill Priestap, the FBI's head of counterintelligence.

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BILL PRIESTAP
Assistant director and head of counterintelligence of the FBI
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JOSEPH PIENKHA
FBI agent
Pienkha was introduced to Bruce Ohr at a Nov. 21, 2016, meeting that included Peter Strzok and Lisa Page, when he was assigned as the FBI's lead investigator of Hillary Clinton.
Pienkha received information from Christopher Steele in 2016. Pienkha then passed the information to Strzok. Pienkha was also present with Strzok during the Jan. 24, 2017, interview of the then-national security adviser Lt. Gen. Michael Flynn.

JAMES CLAPPER
Director of national intelligence
Clapper was the director of national intelligence at the time of the Russia-collusion narrative.
Brennan used unofficial foreign intelligence—including from the UK and Australia—to establish a multi-agency task force. He met personally with GCHQ head Robert Hannigan during the summer of 2016 and would later use the foreign intelligence to push the FBI to open the Trump-Russia counterintelligence investigation. He and DNI Director James Clapper later helped to create the Intelligence Community assessment that was used to push the Trump-Russia narrative.

ROBERT HANNIGAN
Head of Government Communications Headquarters (GCHQ)
Hannigan personally flew to Washington to meet with John Brennan. He abruptly retired days after President Donald Trump's inauguration.

NIGEL INKSTER
Former director of operations and intelligence for MI6
Inkster has known Steele and Chris Burrows for at least 20 years. He is Sir Richard Dearlove's deputy at MI6.

NICHOLAS FISHWICK
Former director of private intelligence firm FBI, former MI6 officer
Fishwick exchanged emails related to the Steele dossier with Chris Burrows during the election.

SIR ANDREW WOOD
Former British ambassador to Russia; contractor for Orbis
Wood briefed Sen. John McCain on the Steele dossier. He advised Steele, whom he knew from the UK Diplomatic Service, both before and after the 2016 election. In 2015, Wood was listed in court documents as a paid consultant for Steele's company, Orbis. Wood knows Sir Richard Dearlove.

SIR RICHARD DEARLOVE
Former head of MI6
Dearlove advised Christopher Steele and his partner Chris Burrows to work with a top British government official in order to pass along information to the FBI.
Dearlove described Steele as the go-to person on Russia. Steele worked as an MI6 agent during Dearlove's tenure as MI6 head.
Dearlove knows Stefan Halper through their mutual association with the Cambridge Intelligence Seminar. He also knows Sir Iain Lobban and maintains ties to UK intel firm Hakluyt.

LOUIS SUSMAN
Advisory board member of Hakluyt; former U.S. ambassador to the UK
Susman made the U.S. ambassador to the UK as a "prize" for his ferocious fundraising on behalf of the Obama campaign.
Leaked diplomatic cables published by WikiLeaks show Susman is also connected to Hillary Clinton.

JONATHAN CLARKE
Former director of U.S. operations at Hakluyt
Clarke co-authored several books with Stefan Halper. Clarke knew Nellie Ohr, Peter Fritsch and the Wilson Center.

SIR IAIN LOBBAN
Advisory board member of Hakluyt; former director of Government Communications Headquarters (GCHQ)
Lobban and Sir Richard Dearlove have known each other for years and have been affiliated in the private sector post-retirement.

JOSEPH MIFSUD
Professor at the London Academy of Diplomacy
Mifsud, a London-based Maltese professor, introduced Trump volunteer campaign adviser George Papadopoulos to the Russian ambassador in London as well as a woman he described as the niece of Russian President Vladimir Putin. He also told Papadopoulos that the Kremlin had "start" on Hillary Clinton.
Mifsud and Papadopoulos both worked at the London Centre for International Law Practice (LCILP) in early 2018. Mifsud reportedly joined LCILP in the fall of 2015, while Papadopoulos reportedly joined in February 2016.
Mifsud has ties to Western intelligence and has been pictured with Clara Smith and Boris Johnson.

STEFAN HALPER
Former deputy assistant secretary of state for public-affairs affairs; advisor to Hakluyt
Halper was closely associated with former MI6 chief Sir Richard Dearlove. He also has close connections to Hakluyt through Jonathan Clarke, who has co-authored two books.
Halper is the "FBI source" identified by the House Intelligence Committee who contacted Carter Page and George Papadopoulos.
A graduate assistant of Halper's invited Page to a July 11-12, 2016, Cambridge symposium where Halper and Page met. Halper would stay in touch with Page over the next 14 months. Halper's contact with Page ended as the final FISA warrant on Page expired.
Halper met with Papadopoulos on Sept. 13, 2016, and a senior Trump campaign official on Sept. 13, 2016. In early November 2016, Halper said he believed that electing Hillary Clinton would be best for U.S.-UK relations.

NATALIA VESELINSKAYA
Lawyer for Prevezon Holdings Ltd.
Veselinskaya attended the June 2016 meeting at Trump Tower with Ronal Akhmetshin to argue against the Magnitsky Act. She hired Fusion GPS in 2015 through law firm BakerHostetler, which represented Prevezon.

ARAS AGALAROV
Russian oligarch
Agalarov is the father of Emin Agalarov. He previously worked with Donald Trump to bring the Miss Universe pageant to Russia.

RINAT AKHMETSHIN
Russian-born lobbyist; alleged facilitator of the 2016 Trump Tower meeting with Natalia Veselinskaya
Akhmetshin is married to Lyudmila Vereshchagina, a Ukrainian national with ties to Ukraine intelligence who has been in the U.S. since 2008. Both Akhmetshin and Vereshchagina knew and communicated with Glen Simpson, Mary Jacoby, and Alexandra Chalupa.

EMIN AGALAROV
Russian pop star and businessman
Agalarov is the son of Aras Agalarov. He was reportedly the subject of a 2016 Trump Tower meeting with Natalia Veselinskaya.

IRAKLY 'IKE' KAVELADZE
Business associate of Aras Agalarov
Kaveladze attended the June 2016 Trump Tower meeting.

ANATOLI SAMOCHORNOV
Translator
Samochornov was a translator present at the June 2016 Trump Tower meeting.

PAUL MANAFORT
Trump campaign chairman from May to August 2016
Manafort, who has longstanding ties to Russian oligarch Oleg Deripaska, communicated during his time at the Trump campaign with Konstantin Kilimnik, his longtime employee in Kiev. In 2016, Manafort was convicted of a number of financial crimes. According to a federal judge, Manafort broke the terms of his plea deal with the special counsel, in part by lying about his interactions with Kilimnik. It appears that Kilimnik facilitated communications between Manafort and Deripaska. Manafort had been under a Title I FISA warrant prior to joining the Trump campaign. Media reports suggest the FBI obtained a new FISA warrant on Manafort after he left the campaign.

GEORGE PAPADOPOULOS
Trump campaign foreign policy adviser
The FBI used Page to obtain a FISA spy warrant that was renewed three times and lasted until October 2017. Page was never charged by the FBI. Page was approached by FBI informant Stefan Halper on July 11, 2016, at a Cambridge symposium. Halper would stay in contact with Page for 14 months, stopping contact exactly as the final FISA warrant on Page expired.

JAMES WOLFE
Director of security for the Senate Intelligence Committee
Wolfe was the director of security for the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence (SSCI) from May 1987 to December 2002. He was responsible for all classified information provided to the SSCI.
Wolfe was accused by the FBI of engaging in unapproved, unauthorized contact with at least four reporters. He was sentenced to two months in prison for lying to the bureau.

BEN RHODES
Deputy national security adviser for Barack Obama
Rhodes has been questioned by the House Intelligence Committee on his role in the unmasking of members of the Trump campaign during the 2016 election.

SHAILAGH MURRAY
Deputy assistant secretary for President Barack Obama
Murray was referred by Rep. Devin Nunes to the House Judiciary and Oversight committees for questioning in an open setting. She is married to Neil Kirk, who works at Fusion GPS.

ADAM SCHIFF
Ranking member of House Intelligence Committee; Democratic congressman for California
Schiff heavily promoted the Russia-collusion narrative. He has been accused of leaking to the media. Schiff publicly urged his constituents in response to the House memo on FISA abuse authored by House Intelligence Committee Chairman Devin Nunes.

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Reid, after being letters to James Comey, urging him to take action. Reid's office posted the letters publicly. Reid was responsible in widespread media attention and the promotion of the Russia-collusion narrative.

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SAMANTHA POWER
U.S. ambassador to the U.N.
Power has been named as a person who made unmasking requests for hundreds of identities. She testified later that others used her name to make such requests.

DAVID CORN
Reporter with Mother Jones
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SAMANTHA POWER
U.S. ambassador to the U.N.
Power has been named as a person who made unmasking requests for hundreds of identities. She testified later that others used her name to make such requests.

DAVID CORN
Reporter with Mother Jones
Corn met with Christopher Steele in late October 2016 via Skype. He subsequently wrote an article—which referenced Alfa Bank—eliciting the existence of the dossier, along with Steele's relationship with the FBI. Corn communicated with top FBI lawyer James Baker prior to the election and provided him with additional parts of the dossier just before or after the election.

DIANNE FEINSTEIN
Republican senator for California
Feinstein leaked the transcript of the testimony Glen Simpson gave to the Senate Judiciary Committee. She received a briefing from John Brennan in August/September 2016. Feinstein's senior intelligence staffer, Daniel Jones, left in 2016 to form Penn Quarter Group, which later hired Fusion GPS and Christopher Steele, following the election.

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McCain received a copy of the Steele dossier through his associate David Kramer. McCain admitted in a Jan. 11, 2017, statement that he had passed the dossier on to James Comey.

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
