HERO BENEFITS

Congratulations on becoming an official hero and part of the Hero Association's Family. The Association has deemed your skills good enough to be put onto the streets as a Hero.

Being an official hero recognizes your efforts of keeping the cities of Earth safe and protecting those in need.

As part of the Association, you're given special benefits and treatments to aid you in your endeavors. You may read about these bonuses in detail further into the book.

Official Recognition

Your heroics are recognized by the Association and the public, as opposed by those who are not and are regularly seen as sociopaths.

Official Rankings

You are automatically ranked in both our ability ratings as well as our popularity rankings. By proving yourself as a hero and a positive member of society, you will be given a rank in one of our classes. You can rise in ranks, as well as fall.

Likewise, you may find yourself swarming with fans in your upcoming career. Like the power rating ranks, you will also be placed in a popularity ranking driven by the members of the community.

Official Hero Name

Over the coming weeks or months, you will be given a unique hero name. Our team of experts will familiarize themselves with your styles, quirks, appearance, and any other qualities to confer a hero name that perfectly fits with you.

Official Hero Equipment

You will be given special hero equipment to aid you while you risk your well-being to protect the innocent. Upon request, the Association will gladly give you the following.

- Hero Association Restraints

You will be given special access to any of the official Hero Association's structures.

Free Medical Services

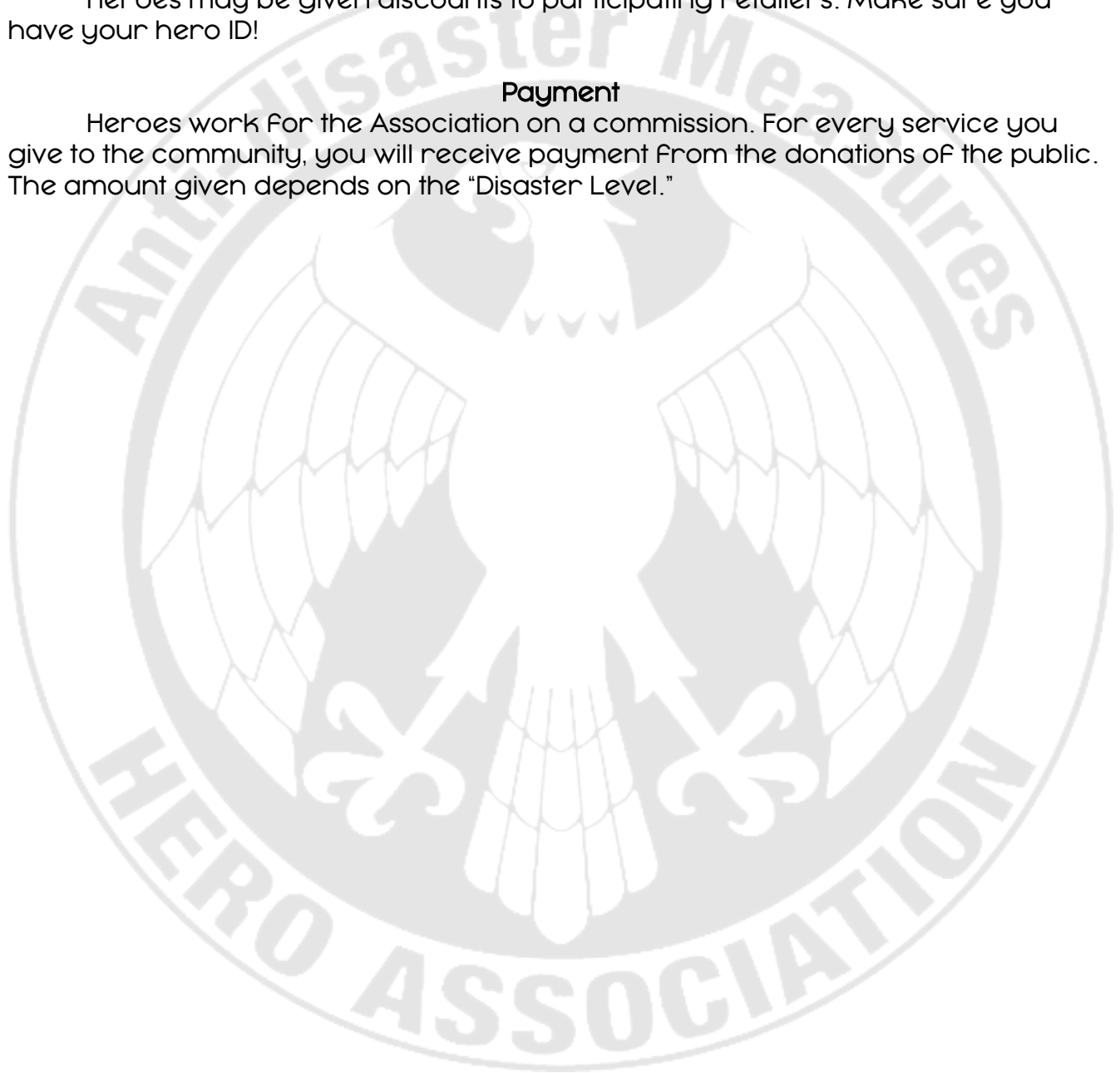
We understand the dangers of being a hero. That is why we give all of our heroes free medical stay and services should the unfortunate event arise.

Heroic Discounts

Heroes may be given discounts to participating retailers. Make sure you have your hero ID!

Payment

Heroes work for the Association on a commission. For every service you give to the community, you will receive payment from the donations of the public. The amount given depends on the "Disaster Level."



Hero Recognition

The Hero Association and the public only recognize those who have gone through the National Hero Registry, and have been officially documented as actual heroes. Those who are not part of the association are seen as delusional weirdos, regardless of how many times they do good.

Official Rankings

Upon completing your tests in the National Hero Registry, you will be placed within a class that best suits your abilities. Based on your Fitness and written tests, you may be placed within one of four classes.

S-Class (17 Heroes)

A-Class (38 Heroes)

B-Class (101 Heroes)

C-Class (390 Heroes)

S-Class represents the strongest members of the Association, with power ratings trailing behind in each class. There are only 546 heroes total within the Association. Each class is ranked from 1 to the maximum amount of people allowed in a class. For example, C-Class members are ranked from 1 to 390. To climb the ranks, one must stay active within the community, and take down evil-doers and monsters. Taking down bigger threats may allow you to leap up multiple ranks in one go. To proceed to the next class up, a hero must be ranked number 1 in their respective class, at which point they can choose to stay at the top of their class, or start at the bottom of their class.

Similarly, it is possible for one to lose ranks. Inactivity and failures to do your job may cause you to lose rank, and in some cases be demoted to the next class down. You may also lose ranks in the event that a hero surpasses you, in which case you should always congratulate your fellow hero. In more extreme cases, heroes can be kicked from the Association or even banned.

You can always see where you rank is at our official website. You may also subscribe to weekly mail updates to see your rank.

Fan Rankings

It's not uncommon for the general public to become a fan of a hero. By an overwhelming petition from the people, we have made an official Fan Ranking System. Members of our community can vote for who their favorite heroes are in a popularity ranking. The most popular heroes tend to travel to every city to do their part and to become loved in the eyes of their community. You may also expect to receive fan letters from the people you have saved. Don't be too surprised to find boxes of letters at your doorstep.

Official Hero Name

You may be devastated to find that your own carefully crafted name won't be accepted into the Registry. We deeply apologize if this is the case, but previous events have forced us to resort to giving out our own official names to the heroes that serve.

The Hero Association has a dedicated team to observe and note every aspect of your deeds. From your style, mannerisms, appearance, and other factors, our team carefully crafts an official name that suits you in every possible way. If you are not happy with the name given, you may petition our staff to change it.

Official Hero Equipment

The Hero Association understands that you need more than just your physique and wits to best an opponent. That is why we offer state of the art equipment to help you on your heroic career.

Hero Association Cell phone

This brand of Cell Phone uses 5g signals so that your calls are never disputed or dropped. The material is high indestructible and completely waterproof. The user interface allows for a hero to quickly call fellow heroes, or the association free of charge. The Association will also have easy access to call you in the event that you are needed to help in a possible disaster, or to warn you of possible nearby dangers. The phones are all hardwired to have a special code number you can dial for emergency backup. *The code is 456** Once you have dialed this code, an alert will go out to the association giving them your GPS coordinates. We do contact nearby heroes to assist you at once.

Hero Association Binoculars

These binoculars offer unprecedented vision of far away things. Crystalline lenses give you a clear picture of distant dangers in a 10x50 field of view that will help you find key details in what you're looking at. These binoculars are incredibly durable, and their size makes it easy to carry around with.

Hero Association Multi-tool kit

No hero should be found without this outstanding kit. The Multi-tool kit contains several different screwdrivers, two knife blades, can opener, file, short ruler, scissors, tweezers, and wire cutters.

Hero Association Video Camera

A small hand-held camera that can record video and audio on tape or digitally, with the capacity of about 6 hours of footage. The footage is in clear 4k video, with a 6-megapixel digital camera alternative. Use this device to capture footage of criminal activity to make it easier for our jury to incarcerate those who do criminal activity or record yourself taking down an evil monster to prove you've been the one who did the work.

Hero Association Restraints

Each pack of restrains comes with 20 extra light and durable plastic cuffs to help you restrain a large number of people where regular handcuffs are impractical.

Hero Association Flashlight

Many heroes find themselves roaming the streets at night, a time where criminal and monster activity seems to muster the most. This Flashlight offers an astounding amount of power to light up even the darkest of nights with a 7x CREE XM-L T6 LED torch. With a battery that can be charged via shaking, you will never find yourself alone in the dark.

Access to the Hero Association's headquarters

Heroes officially document into the Hero Registry are allowed free access into any of the official Hero Association structures dotted along every City. This includes Hero Registry buildings, Bunkers, and the Hero Association Headquarters. Here you may receive free council and advice, voice your concerns, or rest up in a safe environment. The Hero Association does not condone loitering or defacement of official property.

Free Medical Services

We understand the risks you put yourself through to keep everyone safe. There are unpredictable criminals lurking around the corners, and untold dangers of monster that scour the world. Injury is an unfortunate part of being a hero. That is why we give all of our heroes the best medical services, should you require it, free of charge.

Heroic Discounts

If you present your official hero ID to participating stores and retailers, you may be eligible for up to a 25% discount on select products.

Payment

Being a hero is a full-time job. Many of you may find it difficult to juggle the act of saving lives and being a member of the workforce. That is why we offer a base salary that will help you with the cost of living, and additional payment for every service you provide to the community. From the simple act of saving a cat from a tree, to defeating a Dragon-Class monster.

DISASTER LEVELS

We at the Hero's Association have categorized threats with a rank, based on strength and scope of destruction of the particular event. There are 5 threat levels ranging from threatening people to cities, or even the entire world.

Disaster Level God:
Threat to humanity

Disaster Level Dragon:
Threat to multiple cities

Disaster Level Demon:
Threat to a whole city or its functionality

Disaster Level Tiger:
Threat to an unspecified large number of human lives

Disaster Level Wolf:
Appearance of a being or group that might pose a threat

HERO ASSOCIATION RULES AND REGULATIONS

While being a part of the Hero Association, one must follow the rules and regulations provided in this book. Failure to do so may result in demotion, or a ban from being a hero.

- A hero must always obey and follow the law. A hero is not exempt from the law and will be punished two-fold if they break it.
- A hero must never intentionally harm an innocent person. Intentionally harming or showing intent to harm an innocent is swiftly punished with a lifetime ban from the Association.
- A hero must never fight other heroes. It may be tempting to pick on or "rookie crush" another hero, but we are all on the same team. Fighting or killing another hero is prohibited. A friendly spar is allowed so long as injuries can be kept to a minimum.
- A hero must keep public damage to a minimum. We understand that things may get damaged or destroyed during a fight, but please refrain from intentionally damaging or destroying public property.
- A hero must always stand up for the innocent. That means you may have to put your life on the line to save an innocent. You are a hero, and you must withhold the hero name to protect innocent lives.
- C-Class heroes must report a weekly quota of crime fighting. You must show that you are dedicated to becoming a full-time hero, and if you are in C-Class that means you must meet a weekly quota of at least one crime stopped. Failure to do so means losing your hero status. You may apply to become a hero again in the next Registry.
- "Rookie Crushing" groups are prohibited. Themed groups are allowed, but you may not intentionally keep a hero from raising in ranks or class.
- All funds from the Hero Association are from donations. The Hero's Association is not obligated to pay a hero should the Association's funds fall short.
- Headquarters is not your home. Please refrain from staying longer than needed at a dedicated HQ.
- Threat levels may rise and fall as the situation unfolds. Be ready at all times for an announcement.
- Heroes must inform and register with the Association if they will be fighting in an official group. Group names are decided upon by the heroes themselves.
- If you are defeated in battle against a being, it is possible you may not receive credit for its take down unless you are part of a registered group of heroes.
- You may be entitled to the credit of taking down a being even if other heroes have fallen before you.
