B. 1.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The character and scope of the work are set forth in the contract. The Contractor shall furnish and install all materials required by this contract.

In case of differences between small and large-scale drawings, the latter will govern. Where a portion of the work is drawn in detail and the remainder of the work is indicated in outline, the parts drawn in detail shall apply also to all other portions of the work.

1.1 Re-Grouting Floor Tiles

- 1.1.1 Area of floor tiles to be re grouted is approximately 210 square meters
- 1.1.2 Size of the each floor tiles is 50 X 50 cm
- 1.1.3 Remove the existing floor tiles grout for entire house excluding restrooms and closet

- 1.1.4 Use an electric grout remover or electric grout saw without damaging tiles
- 1.1.5 Clean and vacuum out the gaps.
- 1.1.6 Apply a generous amount of grout to grout joints along your tile floor using the rubber grout float.
- 1.1.7 Be sure to distribute extra grout into the grout joints in order to fill them completely.

 Grout all areas of the tile floor
- 1.1.8 Clean floor

1.2 Replacement of Kitchen Floor Tiles

- 1.2.1 Remove kitchen tiles completely, approximately 11 square meter
- 1.2.2 Smooth, level and clean the floor
- 1.2.3 Examine the floor and see if there are any cracks or pits that need to be fixed and use the proper concrete repair kit to repair them.
- 1.2.4 Provide and lay the tiles using the spacers, tiles must be as existing or similar and must be approved by FM prior to install, use tile adhesives to lay the tiles.
- 1.2.5 Apply grout over the tile using the grout float, grout must be matching tiles color and approved by FM

1.3 Repair Windows

- 1.3.1 Remove windows sashes out of frames
- 1.3.2 Evaluate the condition interior and exterior for damages of frames and panels
- 1.3.3 Remove existing weather stripping etc.
- 1.3.4 Repair the frame and sill, replace if required.
- 1.3.5 Seal all joints of windows(sides, bottom and top portion of the frame)

- 1.3.6 Install new rubber gasket/weather stripping
- 1.3.7 Install new windows roller/wheels
- 1.3.8 Install new net screen.
- 1.3.9 Replace Glass (Color to match existing) if cracked or damaged before or during work possibility while removing windows from frame
- 1.3.10 If required remove existing and install new glass protection film.
- 1.3.11 Replace / install new closing device (Handles) with key locking mechanism
- 1.3.12 Dimensions are Approximate 94 x 110cm 120 X 148 cm, exact dimensions are contractor responsibility

1.4 Paint Interior and Exterior

- 1.4.1 Lay drop cloths and tape floor edges.
- 1.4.2 Cover all furniture etc. with drop cloths.
- 1.4.3 Remove all screws, nail and fishers and other objects from the walls.
- 1.4.4 Remove all cover plates from receptacle outlet and switches.
- 1.4.5 Repair /patch holes in all walls and smooth all walls and ceiling.
- 1.4.6 Caulk all wall/woodwork joints with a paintable white silicone/latex caulk, wipe off excess and smooth caulk beads.
- 1.4.7 Tape all woodwork seams with painter's tape. Lay the tape onto the woodwork and press it into the caulk with the corner of putty knife to prevent the wall paint from bleeding behind the tape onto the woodwork.
- 1.4.8 Clean all walls and ceiling with abrasive paper.
- 1.4.9 Paint the ceiling with two coats, approximately 215 square meters, with semi-gloss white emulsion Jotun or equivalent.
- 1.4.10 Paint interior walls with two coats, approximately 310 square meters, with emulsion Jotun Interior # 2060 or equivalent.

- 1.4.11 Paint all doors, closets and closet doors both sides, approximately 140 square meters total, with white enamel gloss Jotun or equivalent.
- 1.4.12 Clean, smooth and paint with two coats 25 exterior window security grilles, stairway hand railing and wall trim with semi-gloss Jotun 1117 or equivalent.

Note: All above dimension are approximate, contractor shall obtain exact measurements.

2.0 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 Prior to start work all material must be approved by Facilities Manager
- 2.2 All materials and labor shall include a warranty of one year.
- 2.3 The period of performance for the project shall be <u>10 working days</u>. Work shall not be performed after regular office hours and weekends.
- 2.4 Work shall be performed during regular business hours on Sunday through Thursday between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Work outside these hours must be approved by the Facilities Manager.
- 2.5 The Contractor shall be responsible for the safety of their personal and safe operation of the equipment's.
- 2.6 The contractor shall have limited escorted entry to the residence where work will be performed.

3.0 SCOPE OF WORK

- 3.1 Logistics:
 - 1. Staging/storage areas available on Consulate grounds.
 - 2. Contractor to provide all equipment needed for material handling too.
 - 3. The contractor is responsible for all transportation of material, equipment and labor to execute the painting project

3.2 Removals:

1. Any Items that effect the work space and need to be removed either temporarily and reinstated; or need to be removed all together and reinstated with new shall be accounted for by the contractor and identified and agreed prior to commencement of any work.

3.3 Finishing & Clean up

1. Clean area of work and restore all items to their existing conditions.

4.0 RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR

- 4.1 The Contractor shall be responsible for the professional quality, technical accuracy, and the coordination of all construction and other services furnished under this contract. The Contractor shall, without additional compensation, correct or revise any errors or deficiencies in its construction and other services.
- 4.2 The Contractor shall identify a Project Site Manager who shall be responsible for the overall management of the project and shall represent the Contractor on the site during construction. The Project Site Manager shall speak English.
- 4.3 The Contractor is responsible for safety and shall comply with all local labor laws, regulations, customs and practices pertaining to labor, safety and similar matters. The Contractor shall promptly report all accidents resulting in lost time, disabling, or fatal injuries to the Consulate.
- 4.4 The Contractor shall be and remain liable to the Consulate in accordance with applicable law for all damages to the Consulate caused by the Contractor's negligent performance of any of the services furnished under this SOW.

5.0 CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

- 5.2 The Contractor shall be responsible for all required materials, equipment and personnel to manage, administer, and supervise the project. All workmanship shall be of good quality and performed in a skillful manner as determined by the Consulate.

The Contractor shall be responsible for any countermeasures or corrective action, within the scope of this contract, which may be required by the Contracting Officer as a result of such inspection.

C.1 SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION

- (a) "Substantial Completion" means the stage in the progress of the work as determined and certified by the Contracting Officer in writing to the Contractor, on which the work (or a portion designated by the Government) is sufficiently complete and satisfactory. Substantial completion means that the property may be occupied or used for the purpose for which it is intended, and only minor items such as touch-up, adjustments, and minor replacements or installations remain to be completed or corrected which:
 - (1) do not interfere with the intended occupancy or utilization of the work, and
 - (2) can be completed or corrected within the time period required for final completion.
- (b) The "date of substantial completion" means the date determined by the Contracting Officer or authorized Government representative as of which substantial completion of the work has been achieved.

Use and Possession upon Substantial Completion - The Government shall have the right to take possession of and use the work upon substantial completion. Upon notice by the Contractor that the work is substantially complete (a Request for Substantial Completion) and an inspection by the Contracting Officer or an authorized Government representative (including any required tests), the Contracting Officer shall furnish the Contractor a Certificate of Substantial Completion. The certificate will be accompanied by a Schedule of Defects listing items of work remaining to be performed, completed or corrected before final completion and acceptance. Failure of the Contracting Officer to list any item of work shall not relieve the Contractor of responsibility for complying with the terms of the contract. The Government's possession or use upon substantial completion shall not be deemed an acceptance of any work under the contract.

C.2 FINAL COMPLETION AND ACCEPTANCE

D.2.1 "Final completion and acceptance" means the stage in the progress of the work as determined by the Contracting Officer and confirmed in writing to the Contractor, at which all work required under the contract has been completed in a satisfactory manner, subject to the

discovery of defects after final completion, and except for items specifically excluded in the notice of final acceptance.

- C.2.2 The "date of final completion and acceptance" means the date determined by the Contracting Officer when final completion of the work has been achieved, as indicated by written notice to the Contractor.
- C.2.3 <u>FINAL INSPECTION AND TESTS</u>. The Contractor shall give the Contracting Officer at least five (5) days advance written notice of the date when the work will be fully completed and ready for final inspection and tests. Final inspection and tests will be started not later than the date specified in the notice unless the Contracting Officer determines that the work is not ready for final inspection and so informs the Contractor.
- C.2.4 <u>FINAL ACCEPTANCE</u>. If the Contracting Officer is satisfied that the work under the contract is complete (with the exception of continuing obligations), the Contracting Officer shall issue to the Contractor a notice of final acceptance and make final payment upon:
 - Satisfactory completion of all required tests,
 - A final inspection that all items by the Contracting Officer listed in the Schedule of Defects have been completed or corrected and that the work is finally complete (subject to the discovery of defects after final completion), and
 - Submittal by the Contractor of all documents and other items required upon completion of the work, including a final request for payment (Request for Final Acceptance).

The Contractor shall submit a schedule, which sequences work so as to minimize disruption at the job site.
- (d) All deliverables shall be in the English language and any system of dimensions (English or metric) shown shall be consistent with that used in the contract. No extension of time shall be allowed due to delay by the Government in approving such deliverables if the Contractor has failed to act promptly and responsively in submitting its deliverables. The Contractor shall identify each deliverable as required by the contract.
- (e) Acceptance of Schedule: When the Government has accepted any time schedule; it shall be binding upon the Contractor. The completion date is fixed and may be extended only by a written contract modification signed by the Contracting Officer. Acceptance or approval of any schedule or revision thereof by the Government shall not:
 - (1) Extend the completion date or obligate the Government to do so,
 - (2) Constitute acceptance or approval of any delay, or
 - (3) Excuse the Contractor from or relieve the Contractor of its obligation to maintain the progress of the work and achieve final completion by the established completion date.

NOTICE OF DELAY

If the Contractor receives a notice of any change in the work, or if any other conditions arise which are likely to cause or are actually causing delays which the Contractor believes may result in late completion of the project, the Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer. The Contractor's notice shall state the effect, if any, of such change or other conditions upon the approved schedule, and shall state in what respects, if any, the relevant schedule or the completion date should be revised. The Contractor shall give such notice promptly, not more than ten (10) days after the first event giving rise to the delay or prospective delay. Only the Contracting Officer may make revisions to the approved time schedule.

NOTICE TO PROCEED

- (a) After receiving and accepting any bonds or evidence of insurance, the Contracting Officer will provide the Contractor a Notice to Proceed. The Contractor must then prosecute the work, commencing and completing performance not later than the time period established in the contract.
- (b) It is possible that the Contracting Officer may elect to issue the Notice to Proceed before receipt and acceptance of any bonds or evidence of insurance. Issuance of a Notice to Proceed by the Government before receipt of the required bonds or insurance certificates or policies shall not be a waiver of the requirement to furnish these documents.

WORKING HOURS

All work shall be performed during **Sunday to Thursday from 08:00 to 17:00.** Other hours, if requested by the Contractor, may be approved by the Contracting Officer's Representative (COR). The Contractor shall give 24 hours in advance to COR who will consider any deviation from the hours identified above. Changes in work hours, initiated by the Contractor, will not be a cause for a price increase.

PRECONSTRUCTION CONFERENCE

A preconstruction conference will be held after contract award at to discuss the schedule, submittals, notice to proceed, mobilization and other important issues that effect construction progress. See FAR 52.236-26.

The Contractor shall hold harmless and indemnify the Government from any and all claims arising therefrom, except in the instance of gross negligence on the part of the Government.

- F.5.1 If the Contractor has knowledge that any actual or potential labor dispute is delaying or threatens to delay the timely performance of this contract, the Contractor shall immediately give notice, including all relevant information, to the Contracting Officer.
- F.5.2 After award, the Contractor has ten calendar days to submit to the Contracting Officer a list of workers and supervisors assigned to this project for the Government to conduct all necessary security checks.

F.7.2 The Contractor shall obtain and furnish to the Government all information required to make any subcontractor's, manufacturer's, or supplier's guarantee or warranty legally binding and effective. The Contractor shall submit both the information and the guarantee or warranty to the Government in sufficient time to permit the Government to meet any time limit specified in the guarantee or warranty, but not later than completion and acceptance of all work under this contract.

F.8.0 EQUITABLE ADJUSTMENTS

Any circumstance for which the contract provides an equitable adjustment that causes a change within the meaning of paragraph (a) of the "Changes" clause shall be treated as a change under that clause; provided, that the Contractor gives the Contracting Officer prompt written notice (within 20 days) stating:

- (b) that the Contractor regards the event as a changed condition for which an equitable adjustment is allowed under the contract
